The fellowship's purpose is to provide opportunities for young postdoctoral researchers from other countries to conduct, under the guidance of their hosts, cooperative research with leading research groups in universities and other Japanese institutions. The program allows such researchers to advance their own research while contributing to the progress of research in Japan and the counterpart countries.

Applications for this program must be submitted to JSPS by a host researcher in Japan through the head of his/her university or institution. They should make this contact well in advance of the host institution's application deadline.

► JSPS Postdoctoral Fellowship Program (Short-term) for North American and European Researchers

The purpose of the program is to provide opportunities to young pre- and post-doctoral researchers from the US, Canada and Europe to conduct, under the guidance of their hosts, cooperative research with leading research groups in universities and other Japanese institutions. In so doing, the program is designed to help advance the research of the visiting fellows, while augmenting opportunities for young researchers to come to Japan from the US, Canada and Europe.

Applications for this program are submitted by a host researcher in Japan who wishes to host a foreign postdoctoral fellow.

Applications for this program must be submitted to JSPS by a host researcher in Japan through the head of his/her university or institution. They should make this contact well in advance of the host institution's application deadline.

▶JSPS Invitation Fellowship Programs for Research in Japan (Short-term)

This program is designed to enable Japanese researchers to invite their foreign colleagues to Japan to participate in cooperative work and other academic activities. Researchers of all countries having diplomatic relations with Japan are* eligible. Applications are submitted by the inviting researchers who wish to host foreign researchers in Japan.

Applications for these programs must be submitted to JSPS by the inviting researchers in Japan through the head of his/her institution. They should make this contact well in advance of the host institution's application deadline.
