National Ilan University was founded in 1926. The University today is home to a wide range of academic disciplines and programs offered by four major colleges: College of Bioresources, College of Engineering, College of Electrical Engineering & Computer Science, and College of Humanity and Management. The school encompasses 15 departments, 17 master programs, 1 PhD programs, and 5 master's programs of professional and continuing studies.

National IIan University is endowed with an immense site of 190 hectares, incorporating three distinct campuses and University-affiliated forestland and farm for internship. The University is located at the heart of Yilan City and in a convenient neighborhood with a 40-minute drive to Taipei 101. The main campus is surrounded by a vibrant community, with shopping complex, cultural center, sports parks, department stores and all kinds of diners and restaurants within one kilometer, offering an all-around community where students have convenient access to basic living necessities.
