National Ilan University was founded in 1926. The University today is home to a wide range of academic disciplines and programs offered by four major colleges: College of Bioresources, College of Engineering, College of Electrical Engineering & Computer Science, and College of Humanity and Management. The school encompasses 15 departments, 17 master programs, 1 PhD programs, and 5 master's programs of professional and continuing studies.

National Ilan University is endowed with an immense site of 190 hectares, incorporating three distinct campuses and University-affiliated forestland and farm for internship. The University is located at the heart of Yilan City and in a convenient neighborhood with a 40-minute drive to Taipei 101. The main campus is surrounded by a vibrant community, with shopping complex, cultural center, sports parks, department stores and all kinds of diners and restaurants within one kilometer, offering an all-around community where students have convenient access to basic living necessities.

Course Load	Exchange students are required to register for a minimum of 2 courses and one of these two must belong to your own department. Overseas students need to take Chinese course.

Accommodation	On-Campus Accommodation : Around NT\$9,500 per semester (the fee is subject to change and summer and winter vacations are not included in the terms of stay). Applicants will be supposed to share a room with 3 other roommates.
Insurance	Students' Safety (or Medical) Insurance of NTD1,055~NTD3,000 per semester
Living Cost Textbooks	NT\$8,000~10,000/month (estimated) NT\$5,000~8,000/semester (estimated) it depends on how many classes students take
Visa Requirement	Once accepted into the Exchange Program, each exchange students will be issued an official Letter of Acceptance from NIU. Exchange students must apply for a valid Visitor or Resident Visa* with the Letter of Acceptance from NIU in their country of residence BEFORE entering Taiwan. More visa information will be provided after the issuance of the official Letter of Acceptance from NIU. * Not applicable to PRC (Chinese) Passport Holders PRC (Chinese) Passport Holders must apply for an Exit and Entry Permit (入出境許可證) BEFORE entering Taiwan, more visa information will be provided after the issuance of the official Letter of Acceptance from NIU.
Orientation Program	The Exchange Student Orientation is MANDATORY for all exchange students. The Exchange Student Orientation provides exchange students with an opportunity to meet other fellow exchange students, to familiarize themselves with the NIU campus and with NIU's academic and administrative policies. Other general information on studying and living in Taiwan will also be provided at the orientation. The Orientation is normally held 5 days before the semester starts.
