### 1. Tuition Exemption System

- Undergraduate students are not eligible for tuition exemption. (Undergraduates who were enrolled in AY 2019 or before are still be able to apply for tuition exemption.)
- Graduate students are able to apply for tuition exemption.
- ●Undergraduate students are able to apply for some funds, such as COVID-19 related special benefits. Make sure to check the **bulletin board** and your **e-mail!**

# University System for Tuition Exemption

	<b>Application Period</b>	<b>Results Notification</b>
First Semester	Late March	Mid-July
Second Semester	Late July to Late September	Mid-January

Depending on the selection process, **full exemption**, **half exemption or no exemption** will be granted.

### **MEXT Honors Scholarship**

Period Amount

October to March of following year 

Amount

448,000/month

- ✓ Availability changes every year
- ✓ AY 2020 results → 2 recipients
- ✓ If there is recipient availability, internal selection will occur
- ✓ Notification of applications around September

### **Employment Promotion Program**

The Employment Promotion Program is for students who desire to work at a Japanese company (in particular, in the San'in Region) after their undergraduate or graduate education.

Recipients are granted this scholarship if they meet the conditions of participation in the **International Student I-turn Employment Promotion Program.**

<b>Amount</b>	¥30,000/month	¥48,000/month
Period	1 year (April to March of following year)	

- ✓ JLPT N2 or higher is required.
- ✓ Notification of applications around April. (AY2022 number of recipients unknown)

# Privately-Financed International Students Scholarship Program Offered by Shimane University International Student Supporters Association

Period	Amount
One time	¥100,000

- ✓ Number of recipients changes every year
- ✓ AY 2020 results  $\rightarrow$  **10** recipients
- Recipients will be selected through internal screening
- ✓ Notification of applications around January

### Types of Private Scholarships

Candidates for <u>scholarships that require a university</u> <u>recommendation</u> are selected through internal screening **twice a year**.

Rotary Yoneyama Scholarship	Required to converse in <b>Japanese</b> (N3 or higher)
Hashiya Scholarship	Required to converse in <b>Japanese</b> (N3 or higher)
Yasuda Scholarship	Required to converse in <b>Japanese</b> (N3 or higher)
Otsuka Scholarship	Japanese or English is OK

- Otsuka Scholarship
   (English applications require a Japanese translation)

National scholarships are more competitive!

Be aware that your chances of receiving a national scholarship are lower compared to local scholarships.

Kyoritsu International Exchanges Scholarship: Asian Countries

Republic of Korea, People's Republic of China, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Macau, Mongolia, Vietnam, Laos, Cambodia, Thailand, Myanmar, Malaysia, Singapore, Indonesia, Philippines, India, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Nepal, Bhutan, East Timor, Brunei, Maldives

- Hashiya Scholarship: Indonesia
- Korean Scholarship: Republic of Korea
