
Financial Statement

HUFS is not the party requiring financial documents for your exchange - the Ministry of Justice (i.e., Immigration) is now requring that exchange students submit (to the univeristy) proof of financial stability following the length of their exchanges:

- 4 months 6,800 USD
- 6 months 10,200 USD
- 10 months 17,000 USD
- 12 months 20,000 USD

This amount must be in a bank account (i.e., a savings account/checking account) in your or your parents' names. Your last names must match or you need to also submit to HUFS a document showing the family relationship. This statement will be requested around the time that we start issuing the Certificates of Admission as your statement must be issued within 30 days of the Certificate's issuance date.



ADMISSION PACKAGE TO PARTNER UNIVERSITY

Above items will be sent via registered air mail upon approval in most cases. Average shipping time is 11 days to most countries from Korea. Please consult with your local Korean embassy/consulate for other documents that you personally may need to provide (items vary by country).

VISA PROCESS

D-2-6 VISA (Study Abroad) is **REQUIRED** before entering Korea.

Students can obtain visa at nearest Korean Embassy with the admission package. An additional step is required for students from the *21 nations listed below.

Health Examination

Students will need to have a health examination for Tuberculosis at a hospital designated by the Korean embassy as part of the visa process. Please consult the Korean embassy or Consulate for further details.

This health exam result can be used for applying to HUFS Dormitory as well.

HEALTH INSURANCE

Students should bring comprehensive travel and medical insurance before coming to Korea and verify that the insurance policy they carry covers hospitalization and medical care occurring during international travel and sojourns, as well as repatriation to their home country in case of medical emergency.

Otherwise, a new law in Korea implemented in Spring 2021 will require students to pay for National Health Insurance Corporation (NHIC)'s monthly premium.

As of Fall 2019, students who wish to take the Intensive Korean Program during winter and/or summer must pay the tuition fee, at 30% discounted rate (about 1,141,000 KRW). From Fall 2020, the program fee has been raised to 1,620,000 KRW.

ACADEMIC CREDITS

Credits and Class Hours

- One credit
 - 16 in-class contact hours = 50 minutes of a regular course or 100 minutes of a lab course/ over a period of no less than two weeks.
- A single class with 3 HUFS credits = 48 hours of class time.
- 12 credits per semester = 192 hours of time spent in class*.
 - *This does not include any study work spent outside of the lecture/lab period.

Undergraduate Students

■ 18 HUFS credits are the very maximum we can allow for exchange and visiting students to take during one semester, but the average regular undergraduate student at HUFS will take between 15 to 17 HUFS credits in order to graduate in 8 semesters with 134 credits.

Graduate Students

 Graduate exchange and visiting students can take a maximum of 12 HUFS credits in graduate-level classes. Due to the nature of adjusting to a new academic environment, we usually recommend our exchange and visiting students to take 12 HUFS credits a semester, with a minimum of 9 HUFS credits.

Intensive Korean Program Students

- Students solely enrolled in the intensive Korean language program are not required to take regular semester courses, but can take up to a maximum of 9 HUFS credits.
- The intensive Korean language program does not offer HUFS credits, but rather offers 200 hours of language instruction. Exchange and visiting students should work with their home universities to determine how they may transfer those hours into their own universities' credits.
