### 1. Academic Schedule & Admission Procedure

- Academic Schedule
- Spring Semester: From March 1 to the third week of June
- Fall Semester: From September 1 to the third week of December
- X If the staring date falls on a weekend, the semester will begin on the following Monday
- Admission Procedure
- 1) Nomination (Exchange Program Coordinator)

To whom is responsible for the International Exchange Program, please fill out the 'Nomination Form' and send it via email to the relative region International Program Coordinator at GNU

\* The 'Nomination Form' will be included in the recruitment notice email

#### 2) Prepare for Application (Student)

Students prepare their application documents based on <2. Application> which is on next page

#### 3) Send the Application (Exchange Program Coordinator)

The application documents prepared according to the guidelines are sent by the student's exchange coordinator at the home university to the GNU program coordinator via email.

## 2. Application

- How to Submit \*\* Deadline November 7, 2025 (Friday)
  - Must be submitted via email through the coordinator at the applicant's home university to GNU international coordinator(mash24@gnu.ac.kr)
  - All required documents **except 'a. Application Form'** must be combined into a **single PDF file**
  - For 'a. Application Form', please submit as MS word file
  - Files name should be written **as** 'HOME UNIVERSITY NAME\_STUDENT NAME (Full name as shown on Passport)' in capital letters
    - ex) For 'a. Application Form' -> SHAKARIM UNIVERSITY\_SANGHYUN SAMUEL MA
    - ex) For other combined PDF -> SHAKARIM UNIVERSITY\_SANGHYUN SAMUEL MA
    - \*\* Please do not just copy and paste the example
  - Original documents do not need to be sent by post
- List of Documents to Submit
- 1) Application Form (Form Provided) (Submit as MS Word file)
- 2) Photo (3.5\*4.5cm)
- 3) Official Academic Transcript

(issued by the home institution in English)

- **X** Graduate students must also submit the official transcript of their undergraduate academic records
- 4) Official Certificate of Enrollment (issued by the home institution in English)
- 5) Copy of Passport \* Picture page and signature page
- 6) Medical Checkup (Form Provided)
- 7) Letter of Recommendation
  - Free Format and must be written in English
  - \*\* Please make sure to include the recommending professor's name, affiliation, position(title), signature(ink or digital), and reason for recommendation
- 8) Permission for the Use of Personal Information (Form Provided)
- \*\* All documents must be prepared in English
- \*\* Only documents issued within 3 months are vaild

## 3. Course Language

- GNU does not have an official English-taught track.
- Majority of courses are taught in Korean
- Courses taught in English may refer to the link below for your reference
- \* Please be noted that the course offerings may vary each semester, so the link should be used just for reference only
- \* As most major courses are taught in Korean, please take special care when submitting your Study Plan required by your home university
- When registering for courses, please note that you may not be permitted to enroll in subjects outside your major, and certain courses may also be restricted based on year grade level or other requirements. However, all courses offered in English are open to exchange students. Therefore, if you are not fluent in Korean, we highly recommend selecting courses from the English-taught course list
- Please note that course restrictions cannot be confirmed until the course registration period begins
- The most up-to-date English-taught course list will be uploaded on the website one (1) month before the start of the semester and can be accessed via the provided link

- Starting from the Spring 2026 semester, an AI interpretation and translation system will be introduced in classes. While professors will continue to teach in Korean, students will be able to follow the lectures by installing an application on their smartphones and using personal earphones with a microphone. Through the application, students can read translated subtitles in English or other languages
- Although this system is expected to greatly help reduce language barriers, please be aware that it may not be completely perfect
- Graduate students are eligible to participate in the exchange program; however, they
  will be registered in the system as undergraduate students for administrative
  purposes. Please note that, regardless of the registration status, exchange students
  who wish to take graduate-level courses must obtain prior approval from the
  respective course instructor

## 5. Course Registration

- Course registration is scheduled one month prior to the commencement of the semester details will be announced via Email to the students
- Our university do not offer an English track. The list of courses taught in English can be found at the link below; however, please note that there is no guarantee that the same courses will be offered every semester. Courses not included in the list are conducted in Korean, and majority courses, especially majors are taught in Korean
- Please be aware that course registration at our university is conducted on a **first-come**, **first-served basis**. As a result, it is quite common that students may not be able to enroll in all the courses they initially planned. Therefore, we strongly recommend preparing **backup course options** (2nd, 3rd choices, etc.) in advance.
- It has also been confirmed that, in certain countries, access to our university's course registration system may be unstable or unavailable. In such cases, you may register for courses during the course adjustment period, which takes place during the first week after the semester begins. However, since this period also follows a first-come, first-served basis, please understand that securing your preferred courses may still be difficult.
- Please note that, as exchange students, exceptions cannot be made to increase class
  capacity or override enrollment limits under any circumstances. We kindly ask you to
  prepare alternative course plans in case you are unable to enroll in your initially intended
  courses.

#### **%** Note

- Most up-to-date English-taught course list for the Fall semester will be updated in August, and for the Spring semester will be updated in February
- Apart from the list, there are basic Korean courses for beginners and intermediates
- The enrollment requirements, such as grade level and department restrictions, may vary for each course. These details can only be confirmed during the actual course registration process
- Credit System: 1 credit consists of 50 minutes coursework per week for 15 weeks during the semester.

## 6. Note for Graduate Students

Graduate students are eligible to participate in the exchange program; however,
they will be registered in the system as undergraduate students for administrative
purposes. Please note that, regardless of the registration status, exchange students
who wish to take graduate-level courses must obtain prior approval from the
respective course instructor

## 7. Arrival Information

- Airport Pick-up service
  - ONLY available for arrivals at Incheon Airport (ICN)
- Orientation
  - Orientation will be held a few days before the start of the semester for the incoming international students
  - The exact date and time will be provided by the person in charge via a separate email

## 8. Health Insurance

- Students are automatically enrolled at Korean National Health Insurance once they have registered for their Alien Registration Card (ARC)
- Registered health insurance is a mandatory for those staying in Korea. It cannot be canceled, even if students have their own insurance from their home country
- Enrollment in the Korean National Health Insurance is mandatory, and the cost must be paid by the student
- Estimated Amount(KRW): 84,150 (each month)

## 1. Welcome Week

- Airport Pickup Service: We provide a pick-up bus from the Incheon airport (ICN) to GNU
- Course Registration: Students may enroll in the course with a Buddy for up to one week following the commencement of the new semester
- Alien Registration: We offer guidance on Alien Registration for a secure life in Korea.

## 2. Buddy / Mentoring Program

- Each incoming exchange students will be matched 1:1 with a Korean students(Buddy Program) who will support the campus life
- Support the Dormitory check-in
- Help with course registration and adjustment to school life from the beginning of the semester
- Support for Korean language and department classes through continuous exchange with each Buddies
- Participate in local and University festivals





# 3. Korean Language Class

#### Purpose

- Korean conversation classes and TOPIK test preparation classes for foreign students
- Improve Korean conversational skills to increase academic achievement and support adaptation in Korea

#### Period and Benefits

- Period: 8~9 weeks < 48-54 Hours >
- Completion criteria: Awarding a certificate of attendance for achieving 80% or higher attendance
- Completion benefits: Tuition waiver
