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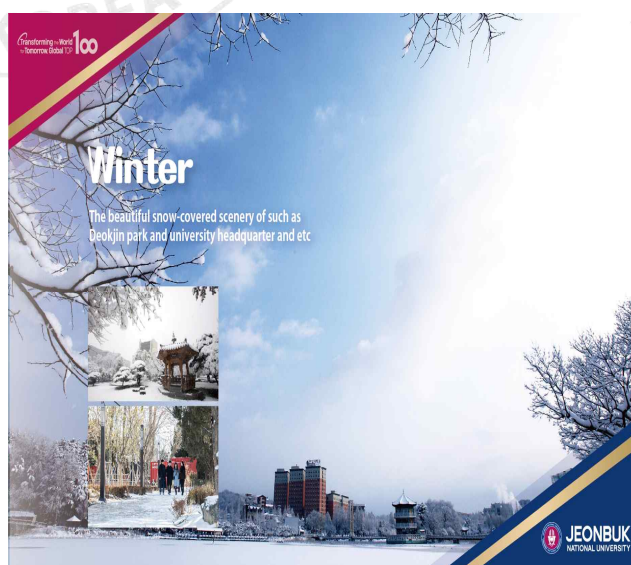

Dormitory(Residence Hall)

A. CHAMBIT HALL

- 1) Fee : Approximately KRW 1,300,000 per semester
- 2) Meals : Provide three meals a day in dormitory restaurant except all weekends.
※ It is not allowed to cook in the dormitory.
- 3) Facilities(Two persons in a room)
 - Each room is furnished with a desk, a chair, an air conditioner, a bed, a wardrobe, and bathroom

B. Dormitory fees

- Fees must be remitted to the dormitory account before entering Korea.
- After the remittance, send the digital copy of remittance slip to **inbound@jbnu.ac.kr**
- Specific details about the payment dates and account information will be notified
- Dormitory fees include water and electricity.

VI Insurance

- ☐ Exchange students are required to have both National Health Insurance and Private Medical Insurance for international students.

A. National Health Insurance Service(NHIS)

- Fee: Approx. KRW75,000/month
- Benefits: Dental Clinic, Medical treatment, Health Checkup. etc.

B. Private Medical Insurance

- Fee: Approx. KRW44,000/6months

※ Students who do not pay their Insurance fee may have in trouble with their visa

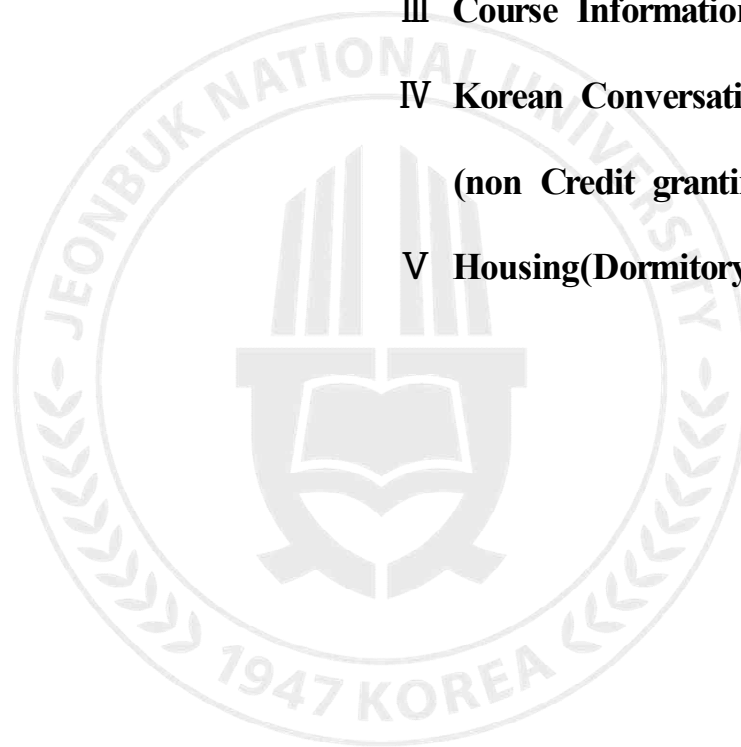

Maximum Applicants per University	30 Students
Eligible Students	Students must first be nominated by their home universities. Undergraduate and Graduate students are eligible to apply. However, graduate students are required to provide a letter of recommendation from a JBNU faculty member with their application.
Duration of Exchange	One or Two semesters.

Language Proficiency Requirements	None. Students with Korean language proficiency may enroll in any courses taught in Korean (TOPIK Level 3 recommended). All students are welcome to enroll in Korean language classes or in courses taught in English.
Required Documents	Completed Application Form Letter of Recommendation from home university (English) Certificate of Enrollment (English) Transcript (English) Study Plan / Statement of Purpose (Korean or English) A photocopy of the student's passport 3 photos of the student (3.5cm×4.5cm, white background)

Courses Taught in English	JBNU offers a wide range of courses taught in English for its international students. A list of courses that have been taught in non-Korean languages (primarily English) during prior semesters at JBNU is available on the OIA website at https://iooffice.jbnu.ac.kr and can be provided upon request. Major of Engineering and Science, Major of International Studies are taught in English as an English Track program. International Studies Major https://tsis.jbnu.ac.kr/ Major of Engineering and Science https://sies.jbnu.ac.kr Office of International Affairs also organizes a special program of courses taught in non-Korean

	languages (primarily English) in a wide range of subject areas. Major courses taught in English are also offered by various departments and Colleges. Such courses are taught at the discretion of faculty and will vary each semester. Students will be able to easily search for and enroll in courses being taught in English or other non-Korean languages during course registration periods.
Enrollment Minimums and Maximums	Courses at JBNU typically award 3 credit hours. Undergraduate Student Minimum-Maximum enrollment per semester: 6-18 credit Graduate Student Minimum-Maximum enrollment per semester: 3-9 credit
***Course tuition fees are waived for exchange students. ***General Korean Language classes are not offered to graduate students.

Korean Conversation Course(non credit granting)

Course Description	This special course is offered to undergraduate and graduate students at various Korean proficiency levels (1- 5) and does not grant university credit. It aims to improve students' Korean language skills through the discussion of various topics related to everyday life and to enhance students' understanding of Korean culture.
Course Fee & Schedule	450,000 KRW / semester 70 hours of instruction are offered in Spring and Fall semesters for one hour per day over 14 weeks.

University Housing[Dormitory]

Chambit Dormitory	Exchange students are guaranteed dormitory placement at Chambit Dormitory if they request it. Dormitory fees include accommodations and 3 meals per day(Mon to Fri). Dormitory rooms are double occupancy with private bathrooms. Dorm amenities include a fitness room, computer lab, reading room, lounge, and laundry room.
Dormitory Fee	About 1,300,000 KRW / semester, including 3 meals from Monday to Friday
Off-campus Housing Assistance	Do not provide off-campus housing assistance.
Payment Deadlines	Spring Semester: End of January
