National Ilan University was founded in 1926. Today, the university is home to many academic disciplines and programs offered by four significant colleges: College of Bioresources, College of Engineering, College of Electrical Engineering & Computer Science, and College of Humanities and Management. The school encompasses 15 departments, 18 master's programs, 1 PhD program, and 5 master's programs of professional and continuing studies.

National Ilan University has an immense site of 190 hectares, incorporating three distinct campuses and University-affiliated forestland and farms for internship. The University is located at the heart of Yilan City and in a convenient neighborhood with a 40-minute drive to Taipei 101. The main campus is surrounded by a vibrant community, with a shopping complex, cultural center, sports parks, department stores, and all kinds of diners and restaurants within one kilometer, offering an all-around community where students have convenient access to basic living necessities.

Nomination Deadline	Spring Semester : 9 October 2025
Application Deadline	Spring Semester : 23 October 2025
Transcripts	After the student has finished their exchange at NIU, we will mail the student's official transcript to the International Office of the partner university.

Deadline for Course Selection	Approximately two weeks after the semester begins
Course Load	Exchange students must register for at least two courses, and one must belong to your department. Overseas students need to take a Chinese course.
Language of Instruction	Chinese (only a few courses are taught in English)
Accommodation	On-Campus Accommodation : Around NT\$9,500 for 18 weeks (the fee is subject to change, and summer and winter vacations are not included in the terms of stay). Successful applicants are more than likely to share a room with three other roommates.
Insurance	The University requires the purchase of group accident insurance (the premium per semester is approximately NT\$1,055). At the same time, Students can also purchase medical insurance (approximately NT\$3,000).
Living Cost	NT\$9,000~12,000/month (estimated)
Textbooks	NT\$5,000~8,000/semester (estimated) depending on how many classes students take
* Incoming students based on a formal Exchange Program are exempt from regular tuition charges and other miscellaneous charges. * The Office of International Affairs will arrange airport pickup and other services. There may be some adjustments according to the epidemic prevention policy.
