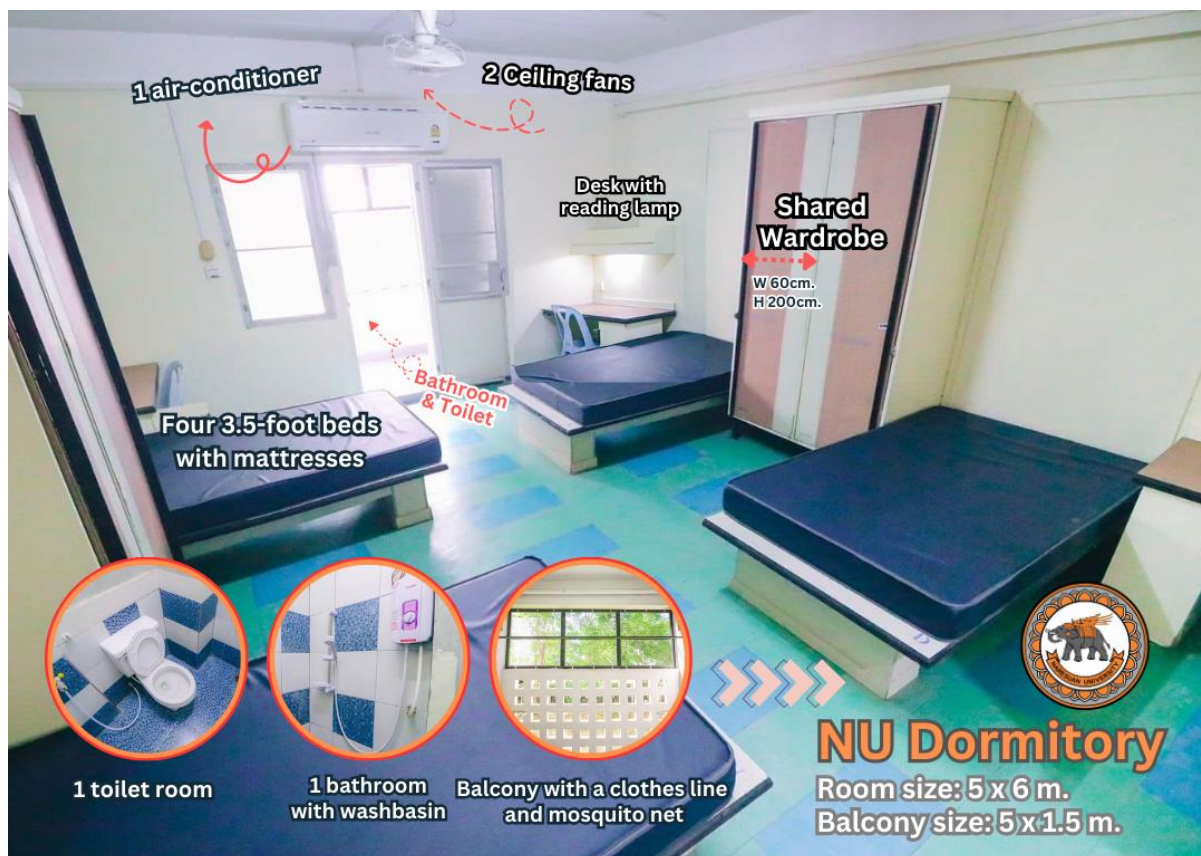
Naresuan University Dormitory Fee

The university residential complex, known as NU Dorm, provides fully furnished accommodation to its occupants, replete with amenities like air conditioning, electric fans, desks, wardrobes, lamps, bathroom facilities, water heaters, and clotheslines. Additionally, the dormitory provides several services including access to reading rooms, wireless internet, household services, pharmaceutical assistance, ambulance services, and common areas. For the NU on-campus dormitory, we have only one room style which is furnished with 4 beds per room and other furniture as in the pictures below. The bedding set (pillow, blanket, bed sheet) and amenities are not provided. International students are accommodation guaranteed accommodation and are expected to comply with the regulations stipulated in the NU Dormitory Rules and Regulations.

Room equipped with fan	4	5,750	The electricity fee for NU Dormitory is 5 THB per unit per month while there is no cost of water. Additionally, students are required to pay for dormitory liability insurance amounting to 1,000 THB and a key deposit of 100 THB upon arrival. The total deposit of 1,100 THB is intended to cover damage insurance and the cost of the room key, and will be refunded upon graduation provided that the Dormitory Office is notified at least 1 month prior to the said event. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the deposit.

Naresuan University Long-term Inbound Exchange Program 2026 - 2027

Overview

The Naresuan University Long-term Inbound Exchange Program 2026-2027 is an initiative dedicated to providing international students with an opportunity to engage in academic exchange activities and spend a semester at our university. The program offers two distinct plans for students to choose from: **Plan A: Global Linkage Inbound Program (GLIP)** or **Plan B**. Both programs offer a variety of projects such as academic coursework aligned with their field of study to gain academic credits, professional internships, or research assistants of research projects. We offer extensive support apart from each program features, which includes airport pick-up at Phitsanulok airport, a comprehensive orientation, a Thai Buddy Program to help them settle in, and dedicated assistance with visa and other necessary documents.

Program Features

Plan A: GLIP

The program offers participants the variety to select their preferred exchange period. The exchange duration is one semester (approximately 3-4 months), following the participant's academic calendar.

Important Note:

The chosen period must fall within the project's designated timeframe. Some projects may have specific duration requirements that are longer than four months.

Scholarships

Tuition fee waivers, a shared room in an on-campus dormitory with another international student (excluding electricity charges), and a stipend of 240 THB per day for living expenses.

Plan B

A key feature of Plan B is that participants in this program will have all tuition fees waived, and will earn academic credits for their involvement. The number of credits awarded is determined by the specific project a student chooses.

Program Duration

One semester based on the Naresuan University academic calendar. Participants may choose to join in November 2026 - March 2027 for 2nd semester of 2026 or June - October 2027 for the 1st Semester of 2027.

Scholarships

Tuition fee waivers

Important remark: The University will select the most qualified candidates to attend the programs at Naresuan University. The final selection result will be made by the Naresuan University committee.
